Here we are - this is it! The main event, the biggest contest of the year - UIL. We have learned many things this year and have worked hard for this contest all year long. Now it's time to show others what we can do, and to put all 5 of our Guidelines for Success together: Be Punctual, Be Prepared, Be Disciplined, Be Relentless, all of which leads to **Be Superior!**

We will record on Wednesday, April 7 at the Belton High School Performing Arts Center (PAC). This is a formal and professional recording, and will not be open to the public for copyright reasons. This is our Band equivalent to the STAAR test. It is **extremely** important, and our students have worked hard to get to this point. Be Prepared with your formal concert attire, which includes: Red polo shirt tucked into **black pants**, black belt for gentlemen, black calf-length socks, and black dress shoes. Be sure to have all of your music, pencil, reeds, and instrument.

Be Disciplined in your behavior and have a positive, focused attitude throughout our entire morning. We will be recording all of our performance to send to the judges. This performance is a major grade and is required. **Students will be required to make up work in their 1st-3rd periods classes.** As always, if you have any questions, please let Mr. Pulley know ASAP.

- **8:00am** - Students will come to the Band Hall instead of going to their 1st period class, and then change into their formal band uniform (see details above).
- **8:15am** - Procedures & Expectations Chat - we will have roll check, uniform inspection, and double-check that everyone has all of their equipment and materials
- **8:30am** - Load big instruments and percussion equipment into Mr. Trahan's van
- **8:45am** - Walk over to HS PAC in uniform and with instruments (bus pickup if raining)
- **9:00am** - Arrive at the PAC and assemble instruments backstage.
- **9:15am** - Timed warm-up begins on stage
- **9:45pm** - Superior concert performance on stage
- **10:00am** - Superior sightreading on stage
- **10:20am** - Pack up instruments and load equipment back into van
- **10:30am** - Walk back over to BMS
- **10:40am** - Arrive at BMS and unload instruments and equipment
- **10:45am** - Change back into school clothes if desired
- **10:55am** - Report late to 3rd period
