



## Jazz-O-Rama Concert

Monday, May 10 at the PAC

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This is the Jazz Band semester exam for Spring 2021. Follow all of these guidelines to earn full credit.

1. Punctual Attendance & Materials 50% - Students must “Be Punctual” for the specific time given for each performance. The call time for this performance is **5:50pm**. Students must also have everything needed for their performance, including instrument and appropriate accessories, their binder/folder with all music, and any other necessary materials such as cords, stands, mallets, and amps.
2. Proper Attire 25% - Proudly wear your black jazz band dress shirt tucked into black pants with a black belt, black **calf-length** socks, and black dress shoes. **Follow all guidelines to earn full credit.**
3. Behavior and Concert Etiquette 25% - Students should always “Be Disciplined” in their behavior and act appropriately both on and off stage, including proper concert etiquette. This includes not talking when someone is speaking or performing, and applauding appropriately after solos and charts.

You are required to stay for the full duration of the concert and we will sit together as a group in the audience. **We also need everyone’s help breaking down the setup after the concert.**

Here is our schedule for the afternoon/evening (please note these times are just an estimate):

- **After School** - Take your instrument and jazz music binder/folder home with you.
- **5:50pm** - Arrive at the High School Band Hall and set up for warm-up. Cases should be stored in your parent’s vehicle beforehand.
- **6:00pm** - Warm-Up in the HS Band Hall
- **6:40pm** - Move to the Stage and Perform
- **7:00pm** - Take your instrument with you to the audience (we will all sit together), and display good concert etiquette for both of the Belton HS Jazz Ensembles
- **7:45pm** - Concert ends and EVERYONE helps break down the setup
- **8:00pm** - Dismissal
