Thursday, May 19

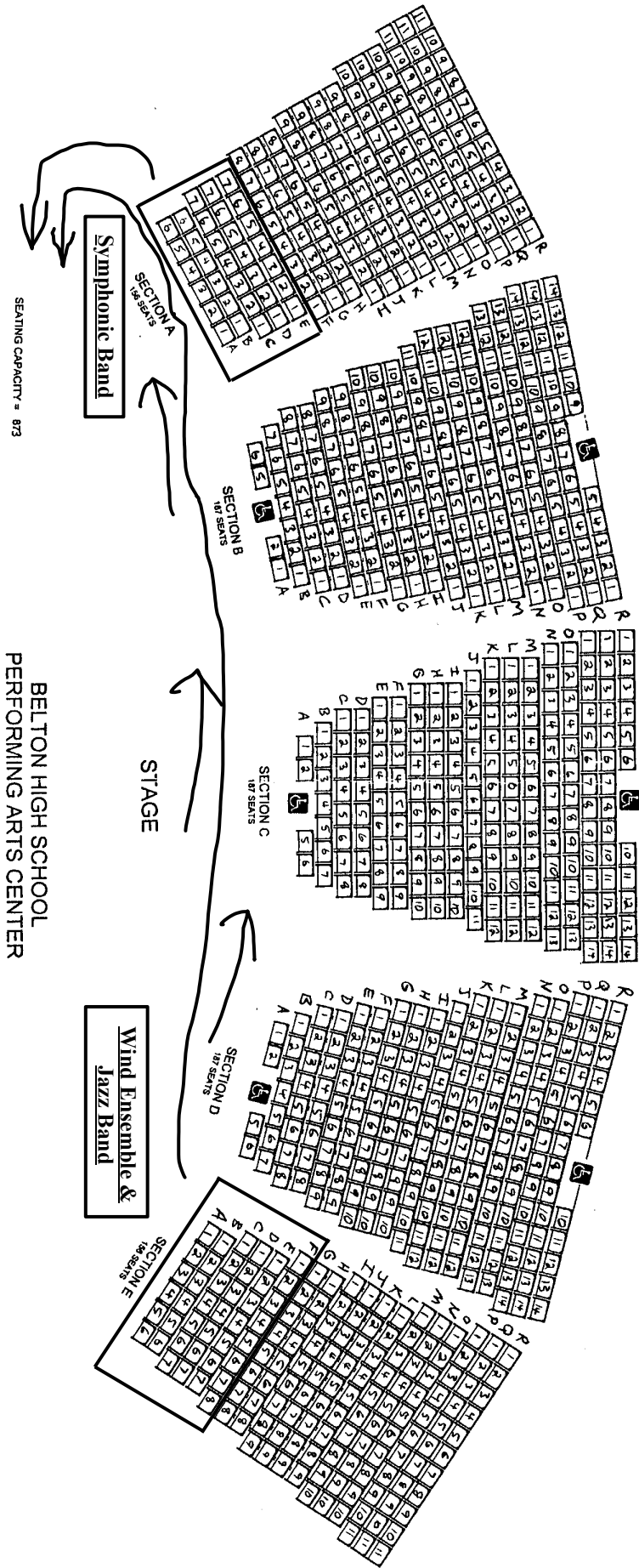
Our 2022 Spring Concert is fast-approaching, so here are the details of our last performance of the year. This required major grade will be held in the PAC at Belton High School on Thursday, May 19. This free concert is open to all friends and family members so they can watch students perform! The Band Hall will close at 4:30pm that day, and students are responsible for taking their instrument and music binder to the PAC. This concert performance is a **major grade** for all band students, and is *critical* to their success as a musician. Please remember that it is not possible to recreate a public performance, and all performances are a required part of our curriculum.

Please review our performance grading rubric and arrive by the specific call time for your group, have all required materials, proudly wear your band uniform properly, and be disciplined in your behavior both on and off the stage. Members of the Beginner's Ensemble will wear their band shirt tucked into jeans (gentlemen wear a belt) with closed-toed shoes. The Symphonic Band and Wind Ensemble will wear their red polo shirt tucked into black pants with black calf-length socks, black closed-toed shoes, and a black belt for gentlemen. **Jazz Band students will wear their black jazz uniform**. When they arrive, students should assemble their instrument and leave their case in their parent's vehicle. Different from our concert in December, all students will meet in the audience section of the PAC, not the HS Band Hall. Consult the attached map for where to report when you arrive at the PAC.
