Spring Concert Itinerary 2023 Friday, May 12

Our 2023 Spring Concert is this week, so here are the details of our last concert of the year. This required major grade will be held in the PAC at Belton High School on Friday, May 12. This free concert is open to all friends and family members so they can watch students perform! The Band Hall will close at 4:30pm that day, and <u>students are responsible for taking their instrument and music binder to the PAC</u>. This concert performance is a **major grade** for all band students, and is *critical* to their success as a musician. Please remember that it is not possible to recreate a public performance, and all performances are a required part of our curriculum.

Please review our performance grading rubric in the Band Handbook and arrive by the specific call time for your group (listed below), have all required materials, proudly wear your band uniform properly, and <u>be disciplined</u> in your behavior both on and off the stage. Members of the Beginner's Ensemble will wear their band shirt tucked into jeans (gentlemen wear a belt) with closed-toed shoes. Beginners will also have 2 group rehearsals on Monday & Tuesday, May 8 & 9 in the Band Hall after school from 4:00-5:00pm. A grade will be taken for both of these required rehearsals.

The Symphonic Band and Wind Ensemble will wear their red polo shirt <u>tucked into black pants</u> with black calf-length socks, black closed-toed shoes, and a black belt for gentlemen. When they arrive, students should assemble their instrument and <u>leave their case in their parent's vehicle</u>. Different from our concert in December, <u>all students will meet in the audience section of the PAC</u>, not the HS Band Hall. Consult the attached map for where to report when you arrive at the PAC. Please follow the schedule below for your ensemble:
